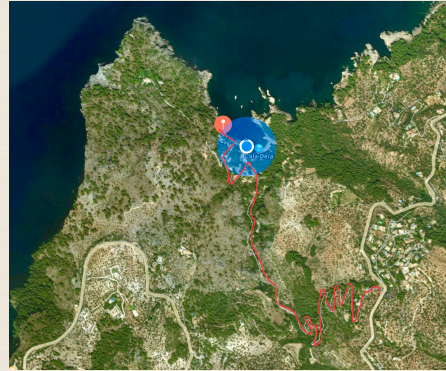

5 Cala Deia



In case of an emergency:

Chemists are obliged to have a pharmacist available. Pharmacists are highly trained and are able to recommend treatment for most common ailments. The chemist in Deia is open all day from Tuesday to Sunday.

Should you need a doctor there is a medical centre in Sóller.

The Medical Centre (Cami d'es Camp Llangollen, s/n Soller Tel: 971 633 011) provides emergency treatment in most cases and will arrange for an ambulance to take the patient to one of the hospitals in Palma if necessary. All treatment is provided by doctors and their trained assistants, and there is usually someone there who speaks a little English or French.

The Sun-Shade

The terrace sun shade is operated with the white remote. **Please retract the sun-shade at night, when leaving the property and especially if the wind picks up.** Wind will damage the unit.

Water

Water on the island is very precious resource especially during the summer months, please try to preserve it as much as possible.

Car Parking

Ca'n Dofi has parking for one car, we request that you park with consideration for our neighbours. If you have an additional car, there is limited parking on the road just before the turning to cliff track.

Rubbish/Recycling

Household waste wheelie bins are at the very top of the road to Cala Deia, please take your rubbish and recycling there during and at the end of your stay. Leaving rubbish outside will attract ants and other nasties!

The Beach - Cala Deia

Cala Deia is a pebbled beach, there is direct access from the path going down the terrace. Just follow the path through Ca's Patro March Restaurant (highly recommended, and now world famous thanks to The Night Manager!) The nearest sandy beach is Port de Soller which is 30 minutes drive away. There are many beautiful beaches on the island and can easily be found with a quick internet search. Please be aware that there can be jellyfish during the summer months, especially after a storm.

Electricity/Fuses

If something stops working e.g water pump, cooker, electrics, check the fuse boxes behind the front door or in the outside utility cupboard. Please turn off the lights when leaving the property (obviously leaving the outside lights on if you are out for the evening).

Hot Water

The thermostat in the boiler is automatic and you should not need to do anything. There are two boilers, one behind the kitchen above the BBQ area of the main house and one to the far side of the studio bedroom below.

Air Conditioning/Heating

There is AC units all over the house, for maximum efficiency please do not set the AC units lower than 19 degrees centigrade and keep all the windows and doors closed. By leaving the front and bathroom windows open there is normally a nice cool breeze from the sea!

TV/Satellite

Turn the TV on using the black remote control and then use the SKY remote to access the channels. Volume is controlled using the black remote.

Laundry

There is a drying rack and tumble dryer in the outside utility cupboard on the lower level.

Cleanliness/Care

We advise keeping the surfaces and floors clean as ants will appear very quickly. Please report any breakages or damage to the house manager so we can ensure that Ca'n Dofi remains fully functional. We will only charge for major breakages and damage due to negligence.

Shopping and Office Hours/Restaurants

Shops are generally open from 09:30 - 13:00 and then from 17:00 - 20:00 Monday to Saturday. Most of the larger retailers and supermarkets are closed on Sundays unless you are in the major tourist areas. Banks and government offices are usually open from 08:00 - 14:00. It is advisable to pre-book restaurants.

Gardener

The gardener (John) usually comes on Tuesday and Saturday afternoons.
